

Amid row over 72 industrial plots, minister says he has returned land

KANPUR: Uttar Pradesh MSME minister Rakesh Sachan was at the centre of a controversy following an allegation that 72 industrial plots were allotted in his name and that of the NGO Abhinav Seva Sansthan, of which he is the chairman, in Fatehpur district in 2012-13. Sachan was the Samajwadi Party (SP) MP from Fatehpur at the time. For his part, Sachan said he had returned the plots in question to the MSME and industries department three days ago.

In a complaint sent to the director of industries on February 11, Laghu Udyog Bharti (Fatehpur) president Satyendra Singh alleged the industries department allotted 32 plots in the Chakhata mini-industrial

estate and 40 plots in the Sudh- vapur mini-industrial estate. HT has a copy of the complaint. Laghu Udyog Bharti is a private organisation that says it helps small industries.

When the industries department in Fatehpur looked into the complaint, it found that 10% of the total cost of properties, which was supposed to be deposited as the minimum amount at the time of allotment, hasn't been paid till date and no industrial unit has been set up at any of the plots.

"The minimum allotment fee is not paid. We started the process of recovery of the money," said general manager, Industries, Fatehpur, Anjish Pratap Singh. People familiar with the matter said the issue of 72 plots allotted to Rakesh Sachan came to light when efforts were under-

way to identify vacant plots in the industrial estates of U.P. ahead of the UP Global Investor Summit-2023 that was held in Lucknow from February 10 to 12, 2023. Anjish Pratap Singh said the plots were allotted in the name of Abhinav Seva Sansthan-Rakesh Sachan in 2012-13 when NK Singh was the general manager, industries, in Fatehpur.

Satyendra Singh, who filed the complaint, said, "I have been asked to produce all the documents and evidence on February 22. I will hand over the documents on the said date."

On being asked about the allotments, MSME minister Rakesh Sachan said 72 plots sounds like a big number but the fact is the total area that was allotted to Abhinav Seva Sansthan was 6000 sq metres and 4800 sq metres respectively at

the two mini-industrial estates.

The land was undeveloped and the allotment was done as the area needed good educational institutions, which Abhinav Seva Sansthan and Seema Shikshan Sansthan were to build with the MSME department, he said. "I have returned all the allotted land to the MSME and industries department three days ago much before these facts came to light because the organisations were not able to develop schools, which are no longer needed," he said. The MSME department has been now asked to allot the land to people who want to set up industrial units, Sachan said.

"There has been no complaint lodged with any authority. The allotments were done in 2012 based on the MSME policy of that time," he said.

High court asks state govt to file affidavit

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LUCKNOW: The Lucknow bench of Allahabad high court on Friday asked the state government to file an affidavit apprising it about the reasons for the death of four children at the Rajkiya Bal Grih, steps taken to ensure proper care of inmates and to prevent such incidents in future.

A division bench of Justice Devendra Kumar Upadhyay and Justice Subhash Vidyarthi passed the order on a PIL filed by lawyer Santosh Srivastava.

The order was yet to be uploaded on the high court's website.

"The court has taken serious note of death of four children at the Rajkiya Bal Grih (Prag Narain road). It has ordered the state government to file affidavit stating reasons for the deaths," said lawyer Santosh Srivastava.

"The court has also directed the state government to inform about steps being taken to ensure that such incidents do not recur and to apprise it about steps taken to ensure proper care of children at the shelter home," he said.

brought into the city's Rajkiya Bal Grih in December last year, died of ill-health between February 10 and 14. Authorities at the government children's home claimed that the infants had arrived in poor health, and their condition worsened through the winters.

The chief medical officer's team, which inspected the home, claimed that authorities had not provided adequate care to the children during December and January, which may have been the cause of death.

'KIDS SHOULD BE FIRST TAKEN TO HOSPITAL'

LUCKNOW : Children, particularly infants brought to the children's home, should first be taken to the hospital for a proper check-up, suggested the health department team that inspected the facility at the Rajkiya Bal Grih on Prag Narain Road, where death of four infants was reported between February 10 and 14.

"If children are brought here with poor health, they should first be sent to hospital. It should be decided whether the child needs hospital care or is healthy enough to stay in the children's home," the two-member panel said in its report on Friday.

The committee members had visited the children's home on Thursday, met the staff and took stock of the facilities there.

FIVE OFFICERS SUSPENDED FOR ILLEGAL MINING

LUCKNOW: The state government suspended five officers and attached three others to headquarters of the mining department on the charges of illegal mining and transportation of minerals.

A spokesperson for the state government said, "Chief minister Yogi Adityanath has directed the state government departments to work on the policy of zero tolerance against corruption." "The directorate of mining is monitoring the working of the officers and employees posted at the headquarters as well as in the districts," he said.

According to the information received from the directorate of mining, complaints were received about illegal transportation of mineral and illegal mining in some districts. The directorate formed teams and conducted raids in Varanasi, Jaunpur, Azamgarh, Mau, Mirzapur and Jhansi districts on February 8 and 9. During the raids, 29 vehicles were caught illegally transporting minerals, he added.

During the raids, 21 vehicles were caught transporting minerals without transit form and 8 vehicles were found transporting minerals in excess of the quantity mentioned in the transit form. The vehicles were challaned online. During interrogation, the transporters said illegal money was collected from mining officers and employees when they in form of entry fees. The team collected evidence of the involvement of the officers in corruption, he said.

Action has been taken against Parijat Tripathi, mines officer, Varanasi, Vineet Singh, mines officer, Jaunpur, Sunil Kumar Maurya, mines inspector, Azamgarh/Mau and Sumit Srivastava, mineral clerk involved in illegal extortion. Action has been also taken against officers, including Rajaram Chauhan, Ashish Kumar Maurya and Ashish Chaudhary, found involved in illegal transportation of minerals. Secretary/director, Uttar Pradesh geology and mining department, Roshan Jacob said, "The mining department is running a statewide campaign to check illegal mining, illegal transportation of minerals and overloading of trucks transporting minerals. Strict action will be taken against any employee/officer found involved in illegal acts."
