

Uneasy calm in Agra after communal tension

Flare-up after woman's body found hanging in her in-laws' house

AGRA : Uneasy calm prevailed in Shahganj area here on Saturday, with heavy force deployment, after Friday night's communal tension. The flare-up was a sequel to a woman's body found hanging in her in-laws' house. The woman and her husband belonged to different religions.

A case was registered against five named accused and three of them, including husband of the deceased, were arrested. The body was cremated after post mortem examination.

As per reports, the woman had married a man from the minority community about a year ago. Her body was found hanging in her in-laws' house who said it was a suicide. But the parents of the deceased, also from Agra, alleged a dowry death.

The matter took a communal turn and rival groups came face to face after BJP Yuva Morcha leaders led by Gaurav Rajawat reached the area. They were reportedly called by the brother of the deceased woman.

The markets were closed on Friday night after some of the shops were targeted. Heavy police force led by SSP Agra Sudhir Kumar Singh reached the spot and the situation was brought under control. Police denied any firing.

"A case was registered against the in-laws of the deceased

under section 304(B) (dowry death) of the Indian Penal Code on the complaint of her brother. Five of the in-laws' family were named and three, including husband of the deceased, arrested," informed the SSP on Saturday.

"The deceased woman, aged about 25, had a court marriage with the man from another religion about a year ago. They had moved away from Agra but returned a couple of months back. The husband worked as a two-wheeler mechanic. The family of the woman was not in

contact with her but her mother got information on Friday evening on phone that her daughter had died," informed the SSP.

"Police became active on getting information and found the body in the house. There was some tension as a group supporting her in-laws and another in favour of her parents gathered but he situation was brought under control," he said.

"Sufficient force, besides PAC, has been deployed. Markets in Shahganj area opened on Saturday and the situation is well under control. No one will be allowed to disturb peace. There are complaints of hooligans creating ruckus in the market area on Friday night. These complaints will be fully investigated and no injustice would be allowed to be done," he said.

BJP MLA Yogendra Upadhyaya and Ram Pratap Singh Chauhan reached the Shahganj police station and demanded action against those guilty of the woman's death.

Activists of BJP youth wing and some right wing bodies gheraoed Shahganj police station on Friday night.

NEW KHERI SP TAKES CHARGE, SETS PRIORITIES

LAKHIMPUR KHERI: Controlling and preventing crime, especially those against women, along with streamlining traffic are some of the key agendas of the new superintendent of police Sanjiv Suman, who took charge on Friday.

A 2014-batch IPS, Sanjiv Suman, was appointed the new SP of Lakhimpur Kheri replacing Vijay Dhull who was transferred late Thursday evening and attached with the Uttar Pradesh state police headquarters in Lucknow.

Talking to media persons on Saturday, Suman said a peculiar problem of traffic mismanagement in Lakhimpur city has drawn his attention.

"Narrow roads and lack of parking places had compounded the problem. I would ensure that traffic on the roads runs smoothly while for some infrastructural issues I would coordinate with respective authorities," he said.

Suman, who has earlier served in Bulandshahr, Azamgarh, Kanpur, Hapur and Lucknow in different capacities, took note of the common grievance of communication gap between the media and the police particularly regarding Tikunia case and said he would look into the issue.

Regarding the October 3 Tikunia violence in which eight people were killed, Suman said the SIT was smoothly conducting the probe into the case.

UPPCL seeks report on charges of undue financial benefits to builder

LUCKNOW : The UP Power Corporation Ltd (UPPCL) has sought a report on the charges of Greater Noida engineers having given undue favour to a builder causing huge revenue loss to the corporation, an official aware of the issue said.

According to them, the UPPCL managing director Pan-

kaj Kumar has written a letter to the Meerut discom managing director to give his report on the alleged irregularities along with the names of engineers responsible for giving undue financial benefits to the builder.

Kumar sought the report after he received a written complaint alleging that the engineers issued power connections to the Gaur Sundaram Residential Scheme in alleged violation

of rules. There are allegations that most of the power infrastructure was developed in such a way that it unduly benefitted the developer depriving the corporation of the revenue.

"The corporation is estimated to have lost at least Rs 10 crore revenue due to the irregularities," said an UPPCL official adding "A Meerut discom director who was then posted in Greater Noida is on the radar."

State govt again extends date for class 10, 12 exam form filling

Advance registration for classes 9 and 11 also extended till Nov 20

PRAYAGRAJ: Taking a big decision in the interest of students, the state government has given one more chance to the students, who were promoted in high school and intermediate without examination in 2021 during the Covid pandemic, to appear in the board examination of 2022 free of cost, if they are unhappy with their result, informed state education department officials.

The last date for advance registration of classes 9 and 11 and online filling of class 10 and 12

examination forms has been extended till November 20. A notification regarding this has also been made available on the official website of UP Board—<https://upmsp.edu.in>.

The certificate-cum-marksheet of 2021 will be provided only to those registered students from 2021 who opt to appear in the 2022 edition of the high school and intermediate exams, said UP Board secretary Divyakant Shukla while confirming the development.

Many students of high school and intermediate have already availed their chance at the mark's improvement examination held from September 18 to October 6, 2021.

All the promoted students, except those who have passed

the marks improvement examination-2021, will be allowed to appear in class 10 and class 12 examination of 2022 free of cost, officials made clear.

In the board exam results of 2021, as many as 1,44,744 students, including 82,238 students of high school and 62,506 students of intermediate do not have marks on their marksheets but were promoted.

These students have been running to their schools as well approaching district inspectors of schools (DIOSs), regional offices of the UP Board and also UP Board headquarters demanding a solution. This latest decision will come as a major relief to them. It is worth noting that earlier, the last date for advance registration of class 9 and class 11, as

well as for filling up the forms for class 10 and class 12 examinations-2022 was November 8, following two extensions.

More than 51.27 lakh students have registered to appear in the UP Board High School and Intermediate Examination-2022 till November 8. Over 27.70 lakh students have registered for the high school exams-2022, while another 23.56 lakh students have registered for intermediate exams, informed UP Board officials.

In terms of advance registrations, around 31.78 lakh students have registered in class 9 and another around 26.62 lakh have registered for class 11, accounting for a total of 58,40,608 total advance registrations, by November 8.

Father among 4 held for murder of woman who married a man against wishes of family

LUCKNOW : Two months after a woman was reported missing from Kanth area of Shahjahanpur district of western UP, police on Saturday arrested four, including the woman's father, for her murder.

Police officials said that the woman married a man against the will of her family. Angered by this, the father along with other family members killed her. The father, a day after killing his daughter, lodged a missing complaint and accused the man she married of kidnapping her.

Commenting on the incident, Superintendent of Police of Shahjahanpur S Anand said, "We have arrested one Budhpal Saxena, 58, along with his son Babloo Saxena, 38, and two rela-

tives Ramesh, 42, and Banwari Lal, 50, for the murder of Roshni Saxena, 19. The girl was reported to be missing in September. After investigation, we came to know that her father Budhpal killed her for marrying a man outside her caste."

According to the police, in July this year, Roshni married one Prabhat, who lives in the same locality, and belongs to a different caste, without informing her family. The duo also got their marriage registered in court on July 14.

"The couple decided to keep their marriage a secret. So, Roshni continued to live with her family. But the father grew suspicious and later came to know about the marriage when he found the marriage registration certificate in Roshni's room. He told us that he smothered her to death in anger and cremated her body at a riverbank in nearby Farrukhabad district with help of other accused," said the SP.

On September 5, a day after killing Roshni, the father

reached Kanth police station and lodged a missing complaint. He accused Prabhat of kidnapping his daughter.

"A case was lodged on the complaint of the father, but during the investigation, it was found that the father and relatives have killed the girl. We have recovered some of her belongings from the place where she was cremated. Based on the evidence, we have booked the father and the relatives for murder and made an arrest," the SP said.
